## ACTIVITIES AND SPECIAL FEATURES

All activities have been designed with fun and adventure in mind. On Saturday, the camp members will be able to participate in many events and activities. Some of our activities will be:

- Black Powder 4x4 shoot\*†
- Archery
- Cobbler cook-off
- Knife/ Hawk Throw\*
- Flint/ Steel
- Love blanket

\*We've included the Knife and Black Powder form which must be signed by a parent in the online registration when posted. Without a signature participation will not be allowed for knife/hawk or black powder.

†Black powder shooting will be limited to only those with a black powder card from the National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association. Please bring your card to camp to participate in any and all black powder events.

- What is a Love Blanket? A Love Blanket is a time-honored tradition to give a gift to someone you would like to recognize. Items are laid out on a blanket in front of the whole group. Members will come up one by one to present their gift and share why they have chosen to bless that person. I encourage all members to partake in this years Love Blanket to share in brotherhood and lift each other up.
- Cobbler cook-off: do you make the best cobbler? Come put it to the test at Fall Trace. Compete against Indiana's finest for a change to win the grand prize.
- Traders row: Like to barter? Set up at traders' row and be prepared to haggle with those Young Bucks working their way up from a wooden spoon. Young bucks must have knife/hawk black powder permission slip signed to bater.



## GROUND RULES/GUIDELINES

No firewood will be provided, bring your own wood.

Everyone is to attend the Council Fire service (this is the focus of our trace event) and the closing assembly on Sunday. We don't want anyone to miss the opportunity to hear our speaker.

Restroom facilities will be available.

You will need to provide for all your meals for your Outpost.

No motor vehicles (cars, trucks, etc...) will be operated in camp other than loading and unloading or meeting other accommodations.

The range is operated and will be maintained by the firearms safety officer. No shooting unless a part of an organized activity is permitted.

All attendees will need to have left camp by noon Sunday to allow for the event following to come in.

# ***TRACE PERSONAL EQUIPMENT***

The following are items that we feel are desirable to take to Trace. Some of the items may not be available to a young buck, so a substitute or deletion may be made at the discretion of the parents. Your son's Commander will be able to help you in making those decisions. We suggest you check off each item as you pack it. Please mark all items with your son's name. These are sample items for a Longhunter. You can get the complete list and other Outfit lists from "FCF Outfit Judging Forms" on the National FCF website (<http://www.nationalfcf.com/>).

If attending the event as a non-FCF member you only are required to bring gear that you would normally bring to a camp out.

**Suggestion: Send this list with your son to use when he is ready to leave Trace.**

## CLOTHING

- Shooters or Hunters frock (Medium weight Jacket)
- Drop front or French fly knee breeches made of heavy linen or homespun (Blue jeans)
- Plain shirt, simple made (linen, homespun, or lindsey/woolsey) No calico (two RR T-shirts)
- Woodland Moccasins, Shoe packs, (tennis shoes)
- Extra outfit (clothing)
- Red underwear – long johns (underclothing)
- Oilskin Frock (Poncho or raincoat)

## PERSONAL ITEMS

- Toilet kit – soap in a case, toothbrush in a case, small tube of toothpaste, comb, towel, and wash cloth.
- Wool Blankets (Sleeping bag)
- Haversack (Dirty clothes bag)
- Bible (small RR OK)
- Quill Pen or pencil (Regular pen or pencil)
- Nessmuk Juice (Insect repellent)
- Corn Boiler & Spoon (horn, wood, or pewter) (Mess kit or plate, spoon, knife & fork)

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Woolen matchcoat (Sweat shirt or sweater) [
- ] Rope Bed (Air mattress and pillow)
- Throwing Knife (Pocket knife)
- Wool or Leather leggings (Sweat pants)
